

Beginner Minecrafter

In this class, students will learn basic controls of Minecraft, game modes, and more. Students will also make their own building in a town using various building blocks on Minecraft.

PREREQUISITE: Students who have no experience to Minecraft.

Intermediate Minecrafter

In this class, students will expand their knowledge of Minecraft. By using mods, students can explore new parts of Minecraft. For example, students can explore the Space Age mod, create a key entry for their house, or paint their house with a bow and arrow. Students will also learn Survival Mode in Minecraft.

PREREQUISITE: Students should have some experience to Minecraft.

Advanced Minecrafter

In this class, students will go beyond what they thought they could do in Minecraft. Students will learn to make a lockable house using Redstone, their own game in Minecraft, and more.

PREREQUISITE: Intermediate Minecrafter

Creative Minecrafter I

In this class, students will unleash their creative side in Minecraft. Students will make their own village and design what they want to make in Minecraft. Students will also be allowed to use mods to help them.

Creative Minecrafter II

In this class, students will use their creativity to make their own dream house in Minecraft. Students will also build their own special door for their house.

PREREQUISITE: Students should have some experience to Minecraft.

Scratch I

In this class, students will learn to code using Scratch (scratch.mit.edu). Students will learn to make a cat move with code. Students will also participate in the Hour of Code.
